DUE: November 1, 2023

Awarded to a graduating senior who is a US Citizen. Please make sure to complete all sections of the application - including all of your extracurricular activities and awards you have received. The Hagan Scholarship Foundation

DUE: December 1, 2023

Awarded to a graduating senior who plans to attend a 4 year college or university after high school. Please see website for scholarship specific requirements and application: <https://haganscholarships.org/>

NYS Insurance Reciprocal (NYSIR) Bambino Scholarship

DUE: March 11, 2024

Awarded to a graduating Special Education student who has worked through his/her challenges to gain acceptance to a college or university. Applications can be found in the Guidance office.

NYS Insurance Reciprocal (NYSIR) Jensen Scholarship

DUE: March 11, 2024

Awarded to a graduating senior who has excelled in design in his/her school career, and who is seeking an opportunity to pursue this path in college. Applications can be found in the Guidance office.

NYS Insurance Reciprocal (NYSIR) Goncalves Scholarship

DUE: March 11, 2024

Awarded to a graduating senior who demonstrates an involvement and work for a cause or organization that promotes social justice, equal opportunity, relief of human suffering, etc. Shows a humanitarian effort. Applications can be found in the Guidance office.

Dante Foundation Scholarship

DUE: March 11, 2024

Awarded to a graduating high school student who is of Italian descent with a successful Academic and Extracurricular record and an above average SAT score. Personal interview is required. Applications can be found in the Guidance office. *Return applications to Mrs. Lang for submission on 3/11/24.*

East End Counselors Association**DUE: March 12, 2024**

Awarded to a graduating senior who intends to major in a "helping field" (nursing, school counseling, teaching or social work). Applicants must submit the application and a one page essay (approximately 500 words) answering: "What has the role of being active within your community or school played in your desire to enter into a helping field?" **Applications found in the Guidance Office. Completed applications should be submitted to Mrs. Lang by 3/12 for submission to East End Counselors Association.**

The League of Women Voters Betty Desch Scholarship**DUE: March 22, 2024**

Awarded to a graduating senior who has been involved in areas of leadership and civic engagement. Application, an essay describing your leadership involvement, and two letters of recommendation - *not from teachers* - are required. Applications can be found in the Guidance office.

Honorable Peter Fox Cohalan Scholarship**DUE: March 31, 2024**

Awarded to a graduating senior who will pursue an undergraduate degree with a concentrated study of a minimum of 24 credits in American History and/or American Government. Application, a Writing Sample, Letters of Recommendation and Transcript are all required to complete the application. **Application details and requirements can be found at <https://www.rdlgfoundation.org/>**

The South Fork Sea Farmers Scholarship**DUE: March 31, 2024**

Awarded to a graduating high school student who will pursue a career in Marine Science, Oceanography, Aquaculture, or a related field. Students must demonstrate financial need, perseverance, leadership, scholarship, and a passion for improving our environment.

The Anthony Bennardo Memorial Scholarship - SBELIH**DUE: April 1, 2024**

Awarded to a graduating senior who is planning to pursue a career in medicine to become a Doctor of Medicine (M.D.) or Doctor of Osteopathy (D.O.). North Fork Community Theatre**DUE: April 8, 2024**

Awarded to a graduating senior that has a history of either performance or off stage experience either in high school or in a local community organization. Applicants must complete an application, submit a high school transcript, write an essay of no more than 250 words, submit a performance resume and letters of recommendation. **Applications can be found in the Guidance Office. The North Fork Breast Health Coalition**DUE: April 8, 2024**

Awarded to a graduating senior who had a parent/legal guardian diagnosed with breast cancer and a resident and student of a North Fork High School. Applications can be found in the Guidance office.

SCOPE Cramer Harrington Memorial Scholar-Athlete Award**DUE: April 12, 2024**

This is a \$1,000 scholarship that will be awarded to graduating seniors who intend to study for a career in education, has maintained at least an 85% average during high school and has been an active athlete during his/her high school career. Essay required answering: 1) How has your educational career inspired you to pursue a career in education (can relate to a person, event, or activity)? OR 2) How have you overcome an obstacle in your life leading you to feel confident in pursuing a career as an educator? Please submit your essay to the Guidance Department PRIOR to the deadline - we will submit the essay to the organization for you.

The Karish Education Fund of the Horticultural Alliance**DUE: April 22, 2024**

Awarded to a graduating senior interested in the field of horticulture (such as botany, landscape, architecture, garden design, and environmental science). Stony Brook Eastern Long Island Hospital Scholarship**DUE: April 26, 2024**

Awarded to a graduating senior who will be pursuing an advanced degree. Preference will be given to those pursuing a degree in a health related field. Recipient will be chosen based on the student's service, spirit and motivation. Additional factors include achievements (not necessarily academic) and demonstration as a good role model for younger students. *Application and essay required. Applications found in the Guidance Office and MUST be returned to the Guidance Office for submission on or before April 26, 2024.*

Suffolk County American Legion Auxiliary Medical Scholarship**DUE: May 1, 2024**

Awarded to a graduating senior who will be pursuing a degree in the medical field. Applicants must show proof of acceptance to accredited medical related programs. Essay, Letter of Recommendation, and application are also required. Applications can be found in the Guidance Office.
